

Action Taken Report

2019-20

June:

- The admission process of the First Year B.A. and B.Com. Classes was done. This year, the admission procedure was done online for the First year and Second Year students.
- “Praveshotsava” was organized on 12-6-2019 for the new entrants to orient them about the various activities carried out by the college throughout the year.
- Classes for the First year students started from the very first day of the term i.e. from 12 June, 2019.
- An inter-class Poster-Making competition was held in collaboration with the Tata Consultancy Services and the NSS units of the college on 14-6-2019.
- Training for the celebration of International Yoga day was imparted to the students and staff of the college by Nehru Yuva Kendra, Valsad from 18 to 20 June, 2019.
- A guest-lecture on “Computer Awareness and Personality Development” was organized on 20-6-2019 by Udisha, the Placement Cell.
- 21 June was celebrated as International Yoga Day. The entire college staff and 191 students participated in it.
- Commencement of the classes for all the three years.

July:

- Enrollment of the new entrants in the NSS and NCC was done. Total 272 volunteers have been enrolled in NSS and 53 cadets have been enrolled in NCC.
- New Time Table has been implemented.

- A guest-lecture on “Information regarding Competitive Examinations” was delivered by the Employment Exchange, Banking Academy under the auspice of Udisha on 9 July, 2019. 108 students availed the information.
